## The Cricket

Golden Oldies Cricket is part of the Golden Oldies family of Sporting Festivals which have been held throughout the world since 1979.

The first Golden Oldies World Cricket Festival was held in Auckland, New Zealand in 1984. Since then Festivals have been held in England, Australia, Canada, South Africa and Sri Lanka.

Adelaide has 13 metropolitan Grade Cricket Club grounds and most are within a w radius of the centre of Adelaide. All clubs have excellent facilities as well as catering and bar facilities. Adelaide Turf Cricket Association has 59 clubs (providing at least 1 oval per club) with more than half also having club room facilities.

Events South Australia and the South Australian Cricket Association have pledged their support from the local Grade Cricket Clubs to provide their facilities for use during the Festival as well as the utilisation of umpires.

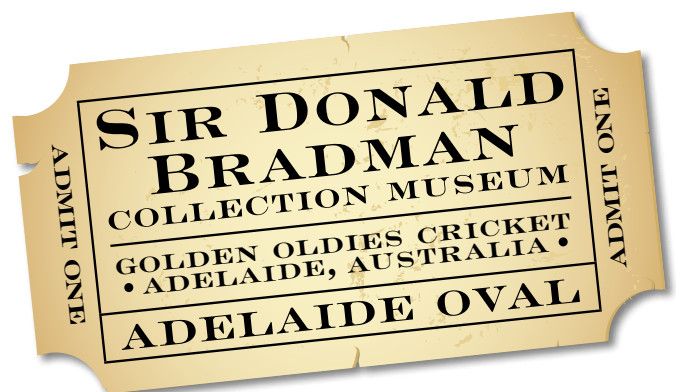

## What's in a name?

The name 'Golden Oldies' does not mean your team cannot play Cricket to the best of its ability or to your teams strengths. The sides you are drawn against will reflect the level of play which you have told us your team prefers, ranging from competitive to social and anywhere in-between.

The difference is we don't publish the scores and there is no overall Festival winner. It's a Festival of Cricket. Age is no barrier except you have to have reached the age of 40 years young to participate.

# CRICKET PACKAGES

## Nothing is left to chance

With Golden Oldies Festivals nothing is left to chance. The Cricket, transport, accommodation and social functions are all planned and co-ordinated for you and your team. In Adelaide we can also ensure the hospitality and enthusiasm of the local Cricket fraternity.

The visitors' Festival package will include:

- Parade of Nations and Opening Ceremony.
- Team Managers' Briefing Meeting.
- Personality of the Day medallions (1 each day, per team).
- Sir Donald Bradman Collection Museum entry.
- 3 days of Cricket.
- Team lunches on the 3 day games.
- 7 nights' accommodation. Your team chooses the level and category of accommodation it wants.
- Air-conditioned coach transfers between your hotel and the Cricket grounds on each game day.
- Air-conditioned coach transfers to and from the official social functions.
- Hospitality and information desks at selected hotels.
- 3 traditional social functions including meals and drinks:
  - Welcome Party - 3 hour function inclusive of substantial finger buffet, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
  - The Midweek Picnic Day - lunch, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
  - Grand Finale Dinner and Air New Zealand Awards - 5 hour function inclusive of 3 course meal, beer, wine, soft drinks and entertainment.
- Festival Souvenir.
- 4 editions of 'Caught Short' - the Festival Newspaper.
- Liaison Officers to assist Team Managers.

## Festival packages

When your entry for the Festival has been received your Team Manager will be sent details of the hotels that we have negotiated rates with and made block bookings. You and your team can then decide on the standard of accommodation and nominate the hotel you want (depending on availability). The tariffs are guaranteed for the Festival.

We will do our best to meet the request your team makes for specific hotels but this may depend upon the room types required.

A Single room supplement will be available upon request as will children's pricing.

## Your entry guide

**Entries:** Team entries must be on the official entry form attached to this brochure and accompanied by the entry fee of AUD300 payable to the "2012 Golden Oldies World Cricket Festival". The entry fee can also be paid by credit card (VISA or MasterCard only) or transferred directly into the Air New Zealand Holidays bank account – see Entry Form for details.

**Teams / Players:** You can enter more than one team if you have sufficient players. The entry fee will apply to each team entry.

**Individuals:** Individual entrants are also welcome to enter and play in a team of their choice or be allocated to a pool team. The entry fee for individual players is AUD50.

**Cancellations and Refunds of Team Entry Fees:** When unforeseen circumstances force a team to withdraw after entering a cancellation policy has been adopted for a refund. To be as fair as possible this is:

Up to 25 November 2011 - Full refund of the entry fee.

From 26 November 2011 - 25 May 2012 - 50% refund.

After 25 May 2012 - No refund.

Please note: If a team cancels but some members still want to attend, they will be welcome and can be merged with other teams.

## The organisation

The games at these Festivals are especially for players aged 40 years and over. They provide fun for all players and focus on participation rather than winning. The whole Festival ensures enjoyment and new experiences for players, partners and supporters.

## Travel insurance

To protect you against loss of deposits and cancellation fees we strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance when you make your first deposit. A series of deposits will be required to secure the Festival Accommodation Package on behalf of your team and a schedule will be included in our formal acknowledgement of your team entry.

Special conditions and cancellation fees will apply to any subsequent cancellation by individuals and / or teams and these conditions will also be detailed in the information sent. Teams are strongly recommended to take out 'Cancellation Insurance' **at the time of payment of their first deposit**, to cover the eventuality of cancellation.



## Conditions of entry

Completing the entry form and paying the entry fee means that you are deemed to have accepted the following conditions:

1. The 2012 Air New Zealand Golden Oldies World Cricket Festival (the 2012 Festival) is an invitation event and the Golden Oldies World Secretariat (World Secretariat) will only accept entries on this basis.
2. All players must be 40 years or older on 25 November 2012.
3. All teams travelling by air must travel on Air New Zealand Limited's services or other approved Star Alliance or partner carrier(s). Details will be provided on request.
4. All teams must complete a form listing all team members names and addresses (whether players or supporters) once the entry has been accepted.
5. All entries will be subject to acceptance by the Golden Oldies World Secretariat which reserves the right to decline or withdraw any entry at any time should it consider there is non-compliance with the 'Conditions of Entry'. If a team is so rejected, any refund of ground package payments will only be made in accordance with the event payment schedule and refund rules applying to all teams.
6. The Golden Oldies World Secretariat reserves the right to determine the maximum number of entries from any one country.
7. Entries will close on 25 September 2012 or at any other time at the discretion of the Golden Oldies World Secretariat.
8. Entries will be accepted from clubs, groups or individuals who wish to form a Golden Oldies Cricket team.
9. Participants normally resident within 100km of Adelaide may purchase a local package. Other teams must purchase an accommodation package.

10. Residential addresses of local team members must be supplied if requested by the Golden Oldies World Secretariat.
11. All teams must complete the official entry form, in this brochure and their appointed representative must sign the Waiver, Release and Indemnity below.
12. Air New Zealand Holidays Limited reserves the right to change any venue of the 2012 Festival or any part thereof, including its removal to another country if it determines such a measure is necessary by reason of changed circumstances or conditions existing or anticipated at the 2012 Festival venue.
13. The Golden Oldies World Secretariat collects participants' personal information in order to conduct the event. If the information requested is not provided the participant may not participate in the event. Please refer to Air New Zealand Limited's Privacy Policy at [www.airnewzealand.co.nz/privacy\\_policy.htm](http://www.airnewzealand.co.nz/privacy_policy.htm) regarding the storage of personal information.
14. All team members will be required to sign a waiver on arrival in Adelaide, as per waiver, release and indemnification below.

Air New Zealand Limited acts only as agents for the providers of ground services included in this package and will not be liable for any injury, cost, damage, expense, loss or delay which may be sustained or occasioned by reason of the negligence or default of any person or sub-contractor engaged to provide such services. Unforeseen circumstances may necessitate the lengthening or shortening of the Festival and in such cases adjustment to the cost of the package will be on a pro-rata basis. No refund will be made if any portion of the 2012 Festival package is unused by the participant. The passenger ticket when issued by the airline concerned shall constitute the sole contract between the carrier concerned and the passenger and carriage by air will be subject to the actual carrier's Conditions of Carriage.
